Terms and Conditions

All data is supplied strictly for academic use as described on the EDINA agcensus subscription form and website. For non-academic use of the data application must be made to EDINA at the Edinburgh University Data Library for which there may be charges.

An Academic or Policy/Research/Commercial subscription allows unlimited access to the Agricultural Census data held in the database for the period of the subscription. Should the duration of the academic study or research project extend beyond the period of the subscription a new subscription will be required.
