

Navigating Land Life Leisure

Advanced search

Enables you to build a more complex search, based on the same headings as the standard search. Boolean statements can be added and restrictions

Standard search

The first screen presented when accessing Land, Life Leisure. A number of different searches are available from here, including subject headings, author, title, source. The most common is to search all aspects of a record using the free text search (all) and type in a few words on your research topic.

Searching Tip

To see related terms in the database consult the Subject Headings or click the links in the results lists.

Extra information

Indexers add information to expand on the title, giving more idea of what the article is about, any interesting features in the article or to lead you towards related websites.

Related website

A live link taken from the article, that points to further information on the topic, or an organisation's website or reports or documents mentioned in the article.

Browse

Allows search for a title, source, author or subject heading, and browse items that are similar.

Marking records

Use this facility to mark records that are interesting, then use the options for either emailing or exporting the full record.

Publication website/full text

Two types of live links relating to the source. The link will either point towards the publication website that may contain further information on the subject area, or to online full text (which may require some additional searching to locate the specific article or press release).

Searching Tip

Combine results sets or store them for later (via search history page)
