## What is Land Life Leisure?

A bibliographic database of rural information, compiled by Aberystwyth University with contributions from the Royal Agricultural College, Harper Adams University College, Kingston Maurward, Myerscough and Pershore Colleges, whose focus is both practical and scholarly.

Some of the subjects covered include current practice and developments in temperate agriculture and all rural topics, including alternative enterprises, conservation, equine enterprises, estate management, forestry, horticulture, organic husbandry, rural planning, recreation and tourism, and environmental issues.

Land Life Leisure covers the popular trade press, in addition to indexing development reports and relevant articles from peer-reviewed journals, making it the only rural information database to index press releases, research journals and the popular press. Over 750 different publications are included, from 1990 to the present, with hundreds of new article descriptions added each week.
